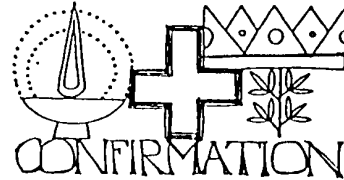

It seems like yesterday that we began our Brick Garden Project. Little by little we are seeing the fruits of our labor. Your response has been overwhelming and for this we are very grateful. We need you to continue to spread the news. We are also happy to report that more and more of you are visiting our web site.

As you will notice, we have placed a temporary fence around the garden. Although these bricks will be replaced with engraved ones, we will want to protect and use these bricks for other projects.

We are delighted to inform you that through the generosity of Scott and Brenda Knight our flagpole will be dedicated to all veterans. Thank you very much Scott and Brenda.

We have the added pleasure of reporting to you that all of the benches have been memorialized. The name of this donor will be announced later.

Presently, we have available the light post - \$850.00, flowerpots - \$600.00 and trees for pots - \$300.00.

In addition we have established a beautification memorial for our Garden. These funds will be used for general purposes, for example: painting surrounding areas and railings, sprinkler repair, rehabbing and installation of ground lights, shrubbery around grotto and various labor costs. These memorials will be as follows:
