Each year, the annual Collection for the Church in Latin America is held in parishes across the country. The proceeds from this collection go directly to support the work of pastoral projects in Mexico, Central and South America, and the Caribbean. When we contribute to this fund, we are actively participating in a work of solidarity with our brothers and sisters throughout the American hemisphere as we build One Church, One America.

Last year, more than \$5 million was raised in the United States to provide collaborative funding for more than 470 projects in 217 dioceses within 21 countries. The funded projects include catechetical and lay leadership programs, youth ministry, evangelization programs, and formation programs for religious, priests, and deacons.
