Subject: Hurricane Dennis Relief

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Miami is accepting only monetary donations to aid our sister Catholic Agencies in the Florida Panhandle, Cuba and Haiti, as they seek to respond to the effects of Hurricane Dennis.

In the Florida Panhandle, thousands are expected to spend the next few weeks without power, making clean water and fresh food difficult to come by. Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Miami has dispatched a team to the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee with food and water. Across the Caribbean, more than 30 people are reported dead in Haiti and Cuba as people deal with flooding and wind-damaged homes and crops.

Monies collected will be directed to Catholic Charities in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee, Caritas Cuba and Catholic Relief Services in Haiti.
