## Music Ministry Update

Congratulations to the Cardinal Gibbons Music Department Chorus for finishing in first place overall in the New York Performance Assessment Concert. These talented students, who have entertained us here at St. Pius for the past two years, earned high praise and acclaim from national judges and international competition. They will be back again next year to sing and play for us but for now Congratulations, for a job well done!!!!

The Church Organ is sadly on its last legs. Over the course of the past few weeks it has been getting progressively worse. We will always do our best to maintain and keep it going for as long as possible; however, that time is getting significantly shorter. Option A – We can conceivably repair the organ, however, there would be no guarantee how long or effective the repairs would be. Also, repairs will cost almost as much as the organ itself is worth at this point. Option B – Find an inexpensive temporary organ until such times as we can raise funds for a new one. The cost of a "temporary" organ would probably be \$10,000 - \$20,000. I feel uncomfortable spending that kind of money on a temporary solution, and it would not be an instrument that adequately meets the needs of the church building. Option C – Begin a capital campaign for a new organ. – A new organ will cost around \$100,000. This will be a beautiful, new and state of the art instrument that will be in the church for the next 20 – 30 years. It will have a full warranty and can be used in many ways to enhance church service as well as concert opportunities. In order for this to be an option we are looking for a few "GUARDIAN ANGELS" to be principal sponsors of this purchase. Sponsorship will include many wonderful rewards which we are working on right now. 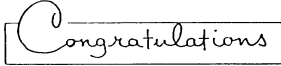
