**Community Health Screening – Tuesday, Nov. 28**

For members of the community who are interested, St. Pius X Church will host a health screening on Tuesday, November 28. On that day, Life Screening will scan the carotid artery in the neck for plaque build up, which can lead to Stroke. They also offer a test for aneurysms in the aortic vessel in the abdomen. Life Line will also offer on that day a bone density screening for women to test for Osteoporosis. These tests, are non-invasive, painless and take only about ten minutes each – cost \$35 a piece.
