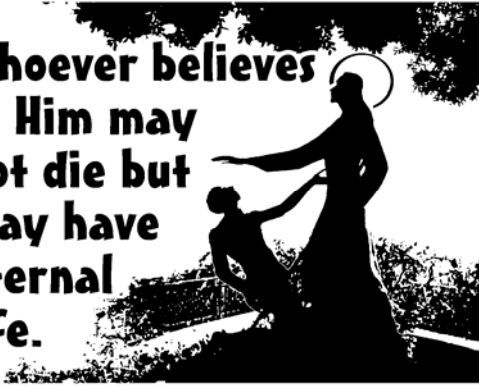


**Whoever believes
