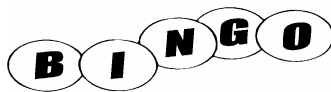

BLESSING OF THROATS - February 3rd

Saint Blaisé & the Blessing of Throats.... Many Catholics remember Saint Blaise's Feast Day because of the Blessing of the Throats that takes place on this day. Two candles are blessed, held slightly open, and pressed against the throat as the blessing is said. Saint Blaise's protection of those with throat troubles comes from a legend that he encountered a child who was choking and about to die, when Saint Blaise healed him.

The traditional **Blessing of Throats** will be given **after** the morning **8:00 & 9:00AM Masses** on **Saturday, February 3rd**, and also, **after all the Masses this weekend.**
