THE LIGHTER SIDE OF LIFE

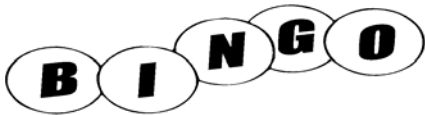
