Fatima Devotions

The Rosary is an old prayer that is always new, leading us to Jesus through Mary. We can trace the beginning of the Rosary to the 12th century when the people who could not read or write would count their prayers on a string of beads. The word rosaries means a garland or bouquet of roses. An early legend connected this word with a story of Our Lady who was seen to take rosebuds from the lips of a young monk when he was reciting Hail Marys and to weave them into a garland, which she placed upon her head. The Blessed Mother urged everyone to pray the rosary during her apparitions at Fatima, Portugal. She called herself the “Lady of the Rosary” and promised that the Rosary would help people grow in their faith, convert sinners and bring about world peace. Please join us in the recitation of the Rosary on Saturday, January 5, at 8:40AM, in the Church.
