It was an interesting letter that Pope John XXIII wrote to the Archbishop of Turin: "Some time ago, I had occasion to say that little David stands always fearless and brave before Goliath the giant. He does not have powerful weapons, and the stones and slings which he holds would seem to be of little help to him. But he advances toward the enemy in the name of the Lord. The humble Pope of the Catholic Church also goes forward and carries with him only this modest and simple object of religious piety, the Rosary of Mary, and he pursues his task in the name of the Lord."

The Rosary might seem small and insignificant, but it is a most powerful instrument. Pope Leo XIII called it "a means of renewing our courage,...a ready means to nurture one's faith and to keep one from ignorance of his religion, and to keep one from the danger of error." Pope Pius XI urged the recitation of the Rosary against the ever-growing evils.
