When the Archdiocese of Miami was formed fifty years ago, one of Archbishop Coleman F. Carroll's first priorities was to build a seminary. He knew that the abundant harvest entrusted to his care would need good and holy laborers. The fruits of his vision and the prayers lifted up by the faithful half a century ago can be seen in our parish today: the priests that faithfully celebrate the Eucharist every day to nourish us in our pilgrimage of faith. During this Golden Jubilee Year, we give special thanks to Almighty God for the faithful service of so many priests and religious through the years. Now we look joyfully to the future and ask the Lord of the harvest to call more men and women to serve Him in the vineyard of the church. Christ has told us: "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest (Mt 9:38)."

Until April -20, 2008 Archbishop Favalora has designated Jubilee Days of Prayer for Vocations, urging all in the Archdiocese of Miami to use these days to pray fervently before the Blessed Sacrament for an increase of vocations to the priesthood and religious life for our Archdiocese. A special monstrance that was blessed by Pope John Paul II during the Year of the Eucharist is traveling each day to a different parish or mission throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, and Monroe Counties.
