Fatima Devotions

The people of the world also suffered in 1917. Our Lady had appeared to the children at Fatima on the thirteenth of each month starting in May. August 13 was an exception, however, because they had been kidnapped and jailed in Ourem. Our Lady appeared to them after their return home, to Valinhos, on August 19.

Fatima is unpretentious. A mountain landscape adds beauty where simplicity and truth abound. Celestial apparitions revealed she was the Mother of God. Mary gave the children various counsels for the future. Fatima's message spread far and wide, crossing the frontiers of Portugal. Pilgrims came in crowds. Fatima, considered the most famous sanctuary to Our Lady in the world, is a place of worship.

"Men must amend their lives and ask pardon for their sins, Men must no longer offend Our Lord, who is already offended too much." This was the message of penance by Our Lady. It asks us not only to repent for past sins, but to expiate them with faith, to break away from sin completely, for sin offends Almighty God and deeply grieves Him.

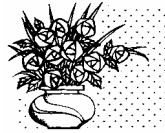
BINGO
