## How awesome.... the gift of faith!

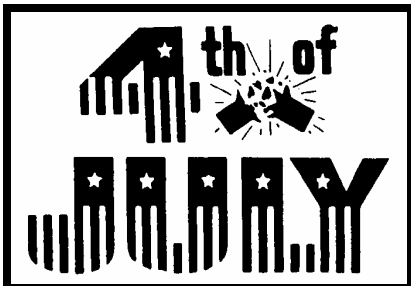
