Wherever Christ is honored, Mary will be honored. Over the years, devotion to the Mother of God has taken various forms at different times and places. One devotion that passed the test of time and is found nearly everywhere is the Rosary.

The Dominican Rosary of fifteen decades links our Lady to her son's salvific career, from the Annunciation and the joyful events of the infancy and childhood of Jesus, through the sorrowful mysteries of His suffering and death, to His Resurrection and Ascension, and the sending of the Spirit to the Apostles at Pentecost, and concluding with the Mother's reunion with her son in the mysteries of the Assumption and Coronation.

It is unwise to reject the Rosary without a trial simply because of the accusations that it comes from the past, that it is repetitious and ill-suited to sophisticated moderns. The scriptural riches of the rosary are of permanent value.
