When a distinguished visitor to the Vatican asked Pope Pius XI what was the most valuable treasure there, the Pope drew from his pocket a well-worn Rosary, pointed to it, and said, "This is the greatest treasure anywhere."

At Lourdes, our Lady appeared some eighteen times and invited Bernadette to say the Rosary with her. In the six appearances at Fatima, our Lady insisted on the recitation of the Rosary.

At Fatima, Mary identified herself, saying, "I am the Lady of the Rosary, and I have come to warn the faithful to amend their lives and ask pardon for their sins....They must say the Rosary."

Through the Rosary today, as in past times of peril that have threatened civilization, Mary has again come to save men from the evils that overwhelm them.
