The following are types of food in need: any kind of soup or canned meat, peanut butter and jelly, crackers, pancake mix and syrup, pasta and pasta sauce, boxed potatoes, cereal and powdered milk. Your donations can be placed in the brown food baskets placed near the entrances to the Church. All non-perishable food items are a blessing to our cause.
