From the Archdiocese of Miami

Due to the recent outbreaks of both Swine Flu and Meningitis, that are both very dangerous and unpredictable health issues, Archbishop Favalora is directing that **at all Masses in the Archdiocese of Miami the Precious Blood is not to be distributed to the congregation (including by intinction) until further notice.**

The pertinent **question of shaking hands at the Sign of Peace** and its health ramifications has also arisen. Within the Roman Rite, the Sign of Peace among the assembly can take the form of a **simple greeting by the words: "Peace be with you,"** and the response: **"And, also with you," without any shaking of hands.** However, this remains an option for the individual, as any form of personal greeting would be in daily society.

Feeding the Hungry

One of the Corporal Works of Mercy, FEEDING THE HUNGRY, is of most importance in these times of economic struggle for so many of our neighbors. Our food donations are processed through the St. Vincent dePaul Society at Blessed Sacrament Church. This past week they served 105 families, representing over 300 persons. So many agencies are striving to feed the nation's hungry, that suppliers of foods can no longer give significant amount of food to the agencies. This is where St. Pius X parishioners can help.

Non-perishable foods such as pasta sauce and pasta, canned meats and fish, peanut butter and jelly, pancake mix and syrup, boxed potatoes, canned fruits and vegetables, jello mixes, powdered milk and cereal are but a few of the needed goods to feed our neighbors.

This will not be a one-shot donation. Please plan to donate often. Your donations can be placed in the food baskets near all of the Church entrances. Almighty God will keep you in His care as you care for His families in need.
