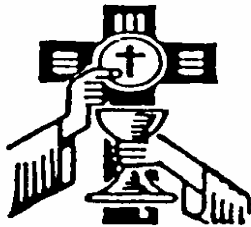


## PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY
