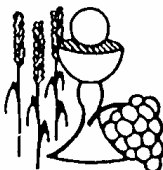




In the afterglow of Easter, our happiness regarding the Resurrection of Our Lord continues. We welcome each of you and invite you to join in this joyful service of worship.

Dear Friends in Christ,
