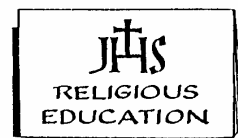
### Feast of St. Pius X

#### Registration Cost:

There will be a \$50 registration fee for the first child, second child will be \$40. This fee will cover books and material needed for the year.

Following the guidelines of the Archdiocese of Miami, preparation for the reception of the sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation requires two years of classroom instruction.

A copy of your child's baptismal certificate is required to register here at St. Pius X.
