Fatima Devotions

On May 13, 1917, during the First World War, the Blessed virgin appeared to three children in Fatima, Portugal. She told the children to give the world a message that would bring the war to an end. The message asked for the recitation of the daily Rosary, Mass and communion on the five first Saturdays, and daily penance. Portugal and Ireland heeded the message and lived it. They were not involved in the Second World War.

The Blessed Virgin told the children, "If my message is not heeded, there will be another most terrible war, whole nations will be annihilated, communism will spread; but in the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph, Russia will be converted, and there will be an era of peace."

Is the triumph near? Are there a sufficient number saying the daily rosary? More than nine decades have come and gone. Something to think about.
